

Rules of the Virtual Drum Set

1. Do not play with wire brushes. The kit is only designed to be played with sticks or nylon brushes (and perhaps your hands).
2. Don't hit the bottoms of cymbals (or drums, for that matter)
3. Don't reach into the bottom of the drum (the area around the trigger)
4. Cymbals are only designed to be played on one side (opposite the Roland logo). Don't rotate them.
5. When not playing, leave the hi-hats in an open position. Releasing the clutch and leaving the hi-hats together for an extensive amount of time can damage the sensor.
6. Be careful with your drumsticks, if you lose your grip you could hit expensive equipment (piano or mics), or someone else in the studio.
